



Multimodal

- DART has pursued a “toolbox” approach to mobility
 - 649 transit buses and 11,271 bus stops
 - 163 light rail vehicles, 64 stations and 93 miles of light rail track
 - 35 miles of commuter rail
 - 13 GoLink zones
 - Paratransit and vanpool
- Streetcar (operated under contract to Dallas)
- Regional connectivity with Trinity Metro, DCTA
- More complete trips through collaboration (Uber, Lyft, Zipcar)









