Construction on the North Tarrant Express is underway!






Project Overview

- Rebuilding existing general purpose lanes
- Improving/expanding frontage lanes
- Adding managed toll lanes



Managed Toll Lanes

- Designed for corridor commuters seeking most reliable and timesaving trip
- Variable tolls based on travel time and demand
- Guaranteed 50 mph traffic flow










Right-of-Way Process

Hurstview Drive










West Segment Activity



- A: Soil work and earth moving at I-35W/820 interchange (thru late February)
- B: Tree removal in Big Fossil Creek area (thru late February)
- C: Movement of traffic in Big Fossil Creek area (early March start date)



East Segment Activity



- 1: Tree removal in Plainview area (thru late February); utility relocation (early March start date)
- 2: Concrete barriers placed under Westpark Way bridge (early March); traffic lanes restriped and shifted towards center so roadwork can begin
