

Trinity Railway Express

- Provides passenger rail service between the cities of Fort Worth and Dallas.
- 34-mile route serves 10 stations
- Anchored at each end by restored railroad stations The T&P passenger rail terminal in Fort Worth opened in 1931 and Dallas Union Station, built in 1916





- TRE has annual ridership of 2.5 million
- 4.4% average per year growth in system ridership for past 6 years
- FTA Ridership Growth Award recipient twice
- New easy-to-read ticket vending machines








SUPER BOWL XLV






